

Minutes of the DDC meeting of Charaideo District held on 30-04-2022 at 12.15 PM in the Conference Hall of DC office, Charaideo

Members present: As per ANNEXURE-I

The meeting was presided over by Sri Paul Barua, ACS, Deputy Commissioner, Charaideo. The Chairman welcomed all the members present in the meeting. The meeting was initiated with the discussion on the action points of the following development departments.


- 1. P & RD:** The CEO, Zila Parishad informed that ADDHAR seeding under MGNREGA up to the end of the month is 43.58%. He informed that 1060 schemes under MGNREGA are in progress. The DC stated that to ensure quality work of schemes taken up in various programme of Rural Development department, the BDO's to arrange Social Audit in every panchayat on quarterly basis. The DC suggested that there should be a target for completion of all schemes /programmes of the department and accordingly, the CEO should take initiative for preparing Action Plan for all schemes of P & RD department. With regards to ADDHAR seeding , the DC asked all BDO's to achieve 100% during the month of May/2022.
- 2. PWD (Roads):** The Ex. Eng. informed that repairing works of potholes up to Garhmur has been done. He stated that under Assam Mala, breadth of the existing road would be extended. He also appraised that survey of road expansion has been completed and reasonable compensation would also provide by govt. to the concerned persons whose land is included in surveyed stretch. With regards to plying of Dumper/ HVM in the Bhojo bridge, the DC directed the DTO to hold discussion with the Ex. Eng. PWD(R) and take necessary action as deem fit.
- 3. Social Welfare:** The DSWO informed that out of 22 Model Anganwadi centres, two Anganwadi centre has been inaugurated and six would be completed in the month of May/22 . She stated that progress of one centre under Lakwa Dev. Block is very poor. The DC asked the BDO Lakwa to submit a report of the said centre immediately. The DC requested the CEO Zila Parishad to visit the sites of Model AW Centres and give suggestion for expedite completion of the projects. The DSWO informed that out of 1648 applications, card generated under UDID is 828 and 95 applications are rejected. With regards to POSHAN, the DC asked the DSWO to submit instalment wise payment report in the next DDC meeting. The DSWO informed that proposal for construction of DSWO's Office has already been submitted to Govt. She mentioned that for construction of Child Care institution in Charaideo, the Director of Social Welfare desires proposal of 4/5 bighas land.
- 4. PHE:** The Ex. Eng. PHE informed the total target of FHTC under JJM in the district is 5,38,999. To implement the schemes expeditiously and complete the targeted FHTC in time, the DC asked the Ex. Eng. PHE to call for the contractors to attend a meeting in a convenient date .
- 5. Water Resource:** The Ex. Eng. Water Resource department stated that out of nine schemes under SDRF, two schemes have been completed .He stated that the progress of remaining seven schemes are ranging from 55% to 60%. He however mentioned that since the ground works of all ongoing schemes are completed, it is opted to complete all the schemes within May/2022 depending upon the condition of weather.
- 6. Education:** Due to absence of IS/DEEO in the meeting, the discussion on the matter of GUNUTSAV was not discussed with the representative of IS (DPO, SSA) attended in the meeting. However the Addl. Deputy Commissioner (Edu.) apprised the meeting that GUNUTSAV in the district will be held from 11th May, 2022. The DC advised that ADC (Edn) to make necessary arrangement for inauguration of model tea garden schools.
- 7. Forest:** The ACF (T) informed that afforestation programme in Kherbari and Lesai is in tendering process. The DFO (SF) informed that plantation of saplings in 21 (twenty one) schools has been completed. He informed that sanction for an amount of ₹ 7.00 lakh for 1.50 hect. nursery has been received. He stated that 1.02 lakh seedlings could be grown in 1.50

hect. nursery and this would be done departmentally. The DC suggested that afforestation programme in reserved forest area should be done by DFO (T) properly.

8. **Irrigation:** The Ex. Eng. Irrigation informed that all schemes under PMKSY have been completed. He informed that water user committees have been constituted and training for operating the solar generating & electric generating pumps also arranged with the committees.
9. **Industry & Commerce :** The representative of the Asstt. Director, DICCC informed that under PMEGP 83 applications were sponsored to banks and out of which 23 applications have been sanctioned. He also informed that online application has been uploaded regarding One District One Product (Charaideo rice).
10. **Agriculture:** The DAO, Charaideo informed that under Paddy Procurement programme, Certificate of registration has exceeded the target but in procurement side 28% has been achieved so far. He informed that 5189 ADDHAR updation for PMKISHAN is completed. The DC asked the DAO to complete the ADDHAR updation by 31st May/22. The DC stated that mixing of paddy in the storage level is a kind of adulteration which needs to be informed to the farmers by DAO. To aware the farmers, the DAO should prepare programme calendar with ADO level so that they may brief the farmers in this regard. The report of preparing programme calendar is to be submitted to DC accordingly. With regards to PM kisan Sanman Nidhi, the DAO informed that 1000 forms have been issued to farmers so far.
11. **Veterinary:** The DVO stated that under National Animal Disease Control Programme (NADCP), 15000 doses of Vaccine received from Govt. and vaccination will be started soon.
12. **Handloom & Textile:** The Supdt. of Handloom & Textile stated that yarn bank under ARTFED no sale during the month due to no stock of yarn available in the bank. He stated that production of Gamocha in the district is going on and seventy six Gamocha has been produced in this month through different weavers. Under APART programme, training of twenty weavers at Charaideo CFC, Lakwa for a duration of ten days has been completed in the categories of Skill development, Designing, etc.. He apprised the meeting that SAMARTH scheme is under process. He informed that under Weavers' MUDRA Loan, out of 50 weavers, Loan distributed to eight weavers.
13. **Fishery:** While discussing the Progress of the scheme RIDF-XXIII - "Ghare Ghare Pukhuri Ghare Ghare Maach", the DFDO stated that 96% work has been completed for construction of pond. He informed that 3013 MT fish has been produced annually in the district. The DC directed to speed up the implementation process of the schemes to fulfil the objectives of Govt and submit a detailed report of works executed by the deptt.
14. **Transport:** The DTO stated that the target for collection of revenue for the district during this year was Rs. 8.00 Crore and out of which an amount of Rs 52.3168lakh has been collected so far. The DC directed to take necessary steps for prevention of road accident and organise awareness programme on Road Safety among the Public. He also directed to hold a meeting with e-rickshaw association for registering e-rickshaw under transport deptt.
15. **Food & Civil Supply:** The Asstt. Director, F & CS informed that the approval of AADHAR seeding has been going on and the achievement till date is 76%. He stated that payment of PFMS has been completed and Ration card holder Identification also completed in all respect.
16. **Health :** The Jt DHS, Charaideo stated that the 2nd dose of vaccination of COVID-19 above 18-year is 84% in the district and advanced dose (3rd dose) for COVID-19 have been vaccinated to more than 3000 people in the district. He stated that for construction of post mortem room, location has been identified in the backside of kitchen room of civil hospital, Charaideo. The DC asked the PWD (bldg) deptt to take immediate necessary step in this regard.

Towards conclusion, the Deputy Commissioner asked all departments to expedite completion of ongoing schemes and submit UC to Govt. He stated that the departments should ensure that the quality of works is maintained in all respect as per Govt. guideline.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks from the Chair.
