Minutes of the DDC meeting for the month of February/2023 in respect of Charaideo District held on 21-02-2022 at 11.00 AM in the Conference Hall of DC office, Charaideo

Members present: As per ANNEXURE-I

The meeting was presided over by Sri Paul Barua, ACS, Deputy Commissioner, Charaideo. The Chairman welcomed all the members present in the meeting. At the very outset, the DC reviewed the District Monitoring Index (DMI) of the departments. The Chairman expressed serious concern about the performance of those departments that have secured low scoring in the DMI. The CEO, Zilla Parishad was asked to expedite the works of Amrit Sarovar scheme in the district. The Chairman directed all the BDOs to visit the scheme sites regularly for proper and timely completion of the scheme before March/2023. To solve the issues of wages of job card holders in implementation of MGNREGA in tea garden areas, the BDOs were asked to prepare specimen copy of letter for sending the concerned bank branches for ADHAAR linkage of the MGNREGA workers bank account. Further, the DC also assured to communicate with the bank authorities in this regard. The CEO, Zilla Parishad informed that Govt. has directed to complete all the old houses under PMAY (G) within March/2023. The meeting was initiated with the discussion on the action points of the following development departments.

1. Social Welfare: The DSWO, Charaideo informed that interview for Anganwadi workers was going on against the vacant posts. During the month of February, thirty awareness programmes have been held in tea garden areas. She informed that internal electricity connection in 28 AWC have been completed. She also informed that the parents of SAM children were not willing to bring to the NRC for Nutrition Rehabilitation. In this regard, the DC asked the DSWO to undertake awareness and motivation

programme among the people in the vulnerable area.

2. PWD (R): The Ex. Eng., PWD(R) informed that the negotiation meeting with the land holder for compensation of land acquisition under Assam Mala Project has been going on since 21st February. The DC directed the EE (PWD) to repair the path holes in the newly constructed road in Bhoju under signature project. The meeting discussed ongoing projects of PMGSY, SOPD(ODS), SOPD(G), RIDF, Signature Project, Assam Darshan, CM's Special Package, APART etc. The Chairman asked the Ex. Eng. to expedite the incomplete schemes under PMGSY, so that 100% completion of schemes under PMGSY could be achieved within March, 2023. In this context, a separate meeting inviting all the contractors would be arranged by PWD(R) under the chairmanship of Deputy Commissioner, Charaideo.

3. PWD (Bldg): The Asstt. Ex. Eng. PWD (Bldg.) informed that the physical progress of construction work of Archery Academy has been achieved 35%. The Deputy Commissioner asked the Asstt. Ex. Eng., PWD (Bldg.) to complete the SP office building and CEO, Zilla Parishad office building urgently. The AEE, PWD (Bldg) informed that the two side boundary walls of sports stadium complex have been completed. The Chairman expressed serious concern on the matter of the inability to construct a morgue by PWD (Bldg.) in Charaideo district. He directed the Asstt. Ex. Eng, PWD (R) to take initiative to construct the morgue in the newly constructed Sonari Medical College site on a priority

basis.

4. Water Resources: The Ex. Eng. stated that all schemes were supervised and implemented through the Sivasagar division, Water Resources. The DC asked the EE whether proper tendering procedures have been followed for implementing the schemes. In reply to the question raised by the DC regarding tendering of works before allotment, the EE stated that online tender has been made for all sanctioned works.

5. Irrigation: The EE, Irrigation informed that out of 25 Irrigation schemes of the district, 24 schemes have been completed. Works of one scheme are going on under RIDF (NABARD) and 90% physical progress of the ongoing scheme has been achieved so far.

He further informed that all solar pumps have been functioning adequately.

6. Environment & Forest: The Range Officer stated that as per direction of the DDC meeting of previous month, compensation of Rs. 6.879 lakh among the 27 victimized families caused by wild animal attack have been paid. He further informed that public meetings have been conducted to ensure the successful online compensation payment to the victimized family by verifying the bank transaction statement. To mitigate the mananimal conflict in the district, necessary actions have been initiated by the forest department in liaison with the public.

7. P&RD: While discussing the various schemes under P& RD, the DC asked the BDOs to inspect the progress of ongoing Amrit Sarovar schemes frequently. The DC also emphasized the progress of PMAY (G) schemes. In this regard he asked the CEO and all BDOs to do the necessary arrangement to construct the houses for the landless beneficiaries on the land which were allotted by the Cos. Those beneficiaries, who are not willing to shift their habitation to the allotted land, a written acknowledgement may be taken from them. The DC also instructed the concerned Forest Range Officer to issue notice to the beneficiaries who are living illegally and encroached forest area. Further, he directed the CEO to prepare a list of defaulting PMAY(G) beneficiaries with the help of concerned BDOs and formal notice to the defaulting beneficiaries may be issued for

8. Health: The Jt. DHS, Charaideo informed that 61,000 Ayushman Bharat cards had been issued out of 2,00,000 targeted beneficiaries. To improve the progress of the issue of Ayushman Bharat card, the DC directed the ADC(Health) to arrange review meetings with the Health Authority and representatives of the insurance company every month so that the target could be achieved expeditiously. The Jt. DHS further informed that the headcount of the target provided by the govt. for SID was not accurate as per the record of the district. The actual head count should be 6780 instead of 8920, which was targeted by the Government. In this regard, the DC suggested to write a letter to the govt. to set the correct target. The Jt. DHS informed that out of the twelve doctors appointed, six doctors have joined in the district. The meeting reviewed the progress of various departmental schemes viz. Mother & Child Health, Institutional Delivery, MMR & IMR, CM free diagnostic service, PM free dialysis programme, Atal Amrit Abhiyan, Ayushman Bharat, NELP, NVBDCP, NTEP etc.

9. Transport: The DTO stated that Rs. 8.00 Crore revenue has been collected out of the targeted 9.52 crore in the district during the year 2022-23. He also informed that regular awareness programmes have been arranged among the public in various places

of the district to mitigate the accident and obey the traffic rules.

10. Library: The Sub-Division Librarian informed that the District Library has increased its membership and readership. Supdt. of Police, Charaideo donated 25 books related to UPSC and APSC to the library to inspire the readers. The Deputy Commissioner suggested that awareness programs should be conducted among the students from class VIII to encourage them to read books and at least one English and one Assamese newspaper should be available in the district library to facilitate the reading of newspapers among the students and readers.

11. Agriculture: The DC directed the DAO, Agriculture to improve the progress of PM KISAN. To enhance the paddy procurement in Angera PPC, the DAO was asked to arrange special awareness camps among the farmers in that area in liaison with F & CS department. The DC suggested that in VGR & PGR, fodder farms for cattle may be grown up. For this purpose, the DAO and the DVO may arrange a meeting to materialize

the programme.

12. F & CS: The Asstt. Director, F & CS informed that NFSA committee has been formed and the selection of beneficiaries would be completed by 28th Feb/2023. He informed that more than 12000 MT paddy has been procured so far.

13. DDMA: The DPO informed that to pay the ex-gratia amongst the affected families, Rs. 40.00 lakh is yet to be received from Govt. The DC asked the DPO to arrange flood preparation meeting in advance for the district.

- 14. Veterinary: The DVO stated that under SOPD-G, 20,000 DOC (Broiler) have been distributed among 400 women beneficiaries in the FY 2022-23 in the district. The DC directed to the Veterinary fodder farm in PGR/VGR land and the proposal may be submitted to the Deputy Commissioner, Charaideo.
- **15. Handloom & Textile**: The Supdt. of Handloom & Textile stated that under APART programme for the year 2021-22, 100% Physical achievement has been achieved. He apprised that under SAMARTH, training of 60 weavers has been going on at two training centres. He informed that under Weavers' MUDRA Loan for the financial year 2022-23, 41 applications have been submitted to various bank for sanction. He further informed that procurement of gamusa from weavers worth Rs. 5.00 lakh has been made in the district.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks from the Chair.
