



Introduction: Charaideo district was the first permanent capital of Ahom kingdom and always held a prominent place in records of history in terms of disaster. The district is located on the eastern part of Sivasagar district and is bounded by Dibrugarh district in the North & East, Nagaland and Arunachal Pradesh in the South and Nazira Sub-Division of Sivasagar district in the West. The main rivers flowing throughout the district are Desang, Towkak, Suffry, Timon and Teok. Charaideo is mainly affected by flash flood because the district is situated on the foothills of Nagaland and Arunachal Pradesh.

Flood:

Introduction

Following the enactment of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, (DM Act, 2005) the Government of India (GOI) constituted the National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) as the apex body for Disaster Management (DM) in India with the mandate, inter alia, for laying down policies and guidelines on DM. At the national level, there is to be a paradigm shift from the erstwhile relief centric and post-event syndrome to pro-active prevention-, mitigation- and preparedness-driven DM. These efforts will conserve developmental gains and also minimize loss of lives, livelihood systems and property. These Guidelines have been evolved by the NDMA, through a nine-step process. This approach ensures that all contemporary knowledge, experience and information are taken on board, clear destinations are identified, and road maps drawn with milestones duly marked off through a wide consultative process, involving all the stakeholders. Recognizing the gravity of the risk and vulnerability of India to floods, the NDMA, soon after its constitution initiated a series of consultations with the various stakeholders to develop Guidelines for strengthening the existing arrangements for flood preparedness, mitigation, and post-flood emergency response, relief, rehabilitation and reconstruction. Senior representatives from the Central Ministries/ Departments and the state governments, related agencies, academics and professionals attended these meetings. The meetings acknowledged that, while several significant initiatives had been taken by government agencies in the past for addressing the risk and vulnerability of India to floods, it is necessary to undertake measures for the evolution of a holistic and integrated strategy to address the critical factors that accentuate flood risk. On the basis of these deliberations, the NDMA has prepared these Guidelines for Flood Management (FM), to assist the ministries and departments of the GOI, the state governments and other agencies in preparing Flood Management plans (FMPs).

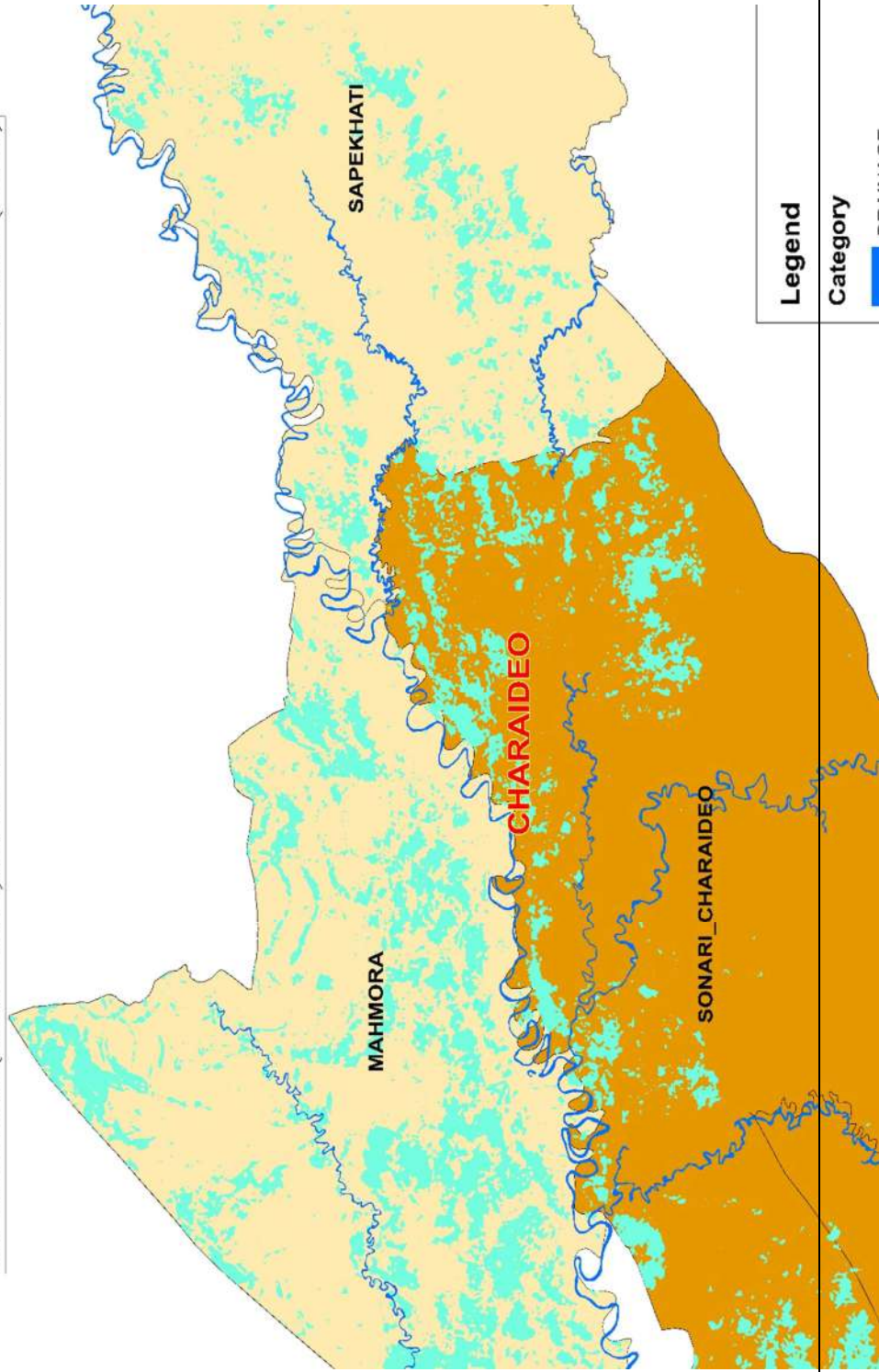
Vulnerability to Floods: Charaideo District:

Floods have been a recurrent phenomenon in Assam and cause huge losses to lives, properties, livelihood systems, infrastructure and public utilities. In the recent years the worst flood experienced in Charaideo was in the year 2017. The frequency of major floods is more than once in five years. Floods have also occurred in areas, which were earlier not considered flood prone. An effort has been made in these guidelines to cover the entire gamut of Flood Management. Eighty per cent of the precipitation takes place in the monsoon months from June to September. The rivers Desang and Towkak bring heavy sediment load from the catchments. These, coupled with inadequate carrying capacity of the rivers are responsible for causing floods, drainage congestion and erosion of river-banks. The fact that the rivers causing damage in Charaideo originate in neighboring states, adds another complex dimension to the problem. Continuing and large scale loss of lives and damage to public and private property due to floods indicate that we are still to develop an effective response to floods.

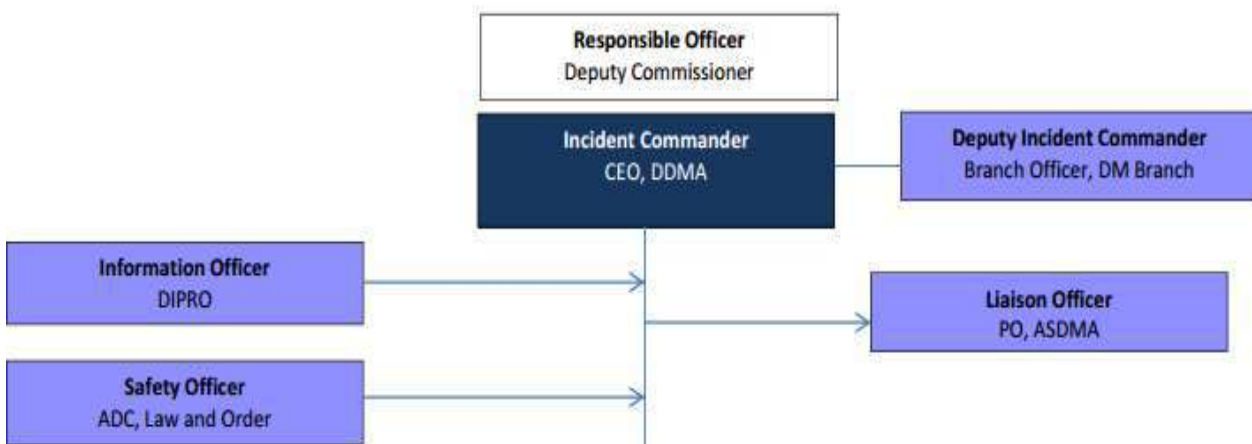

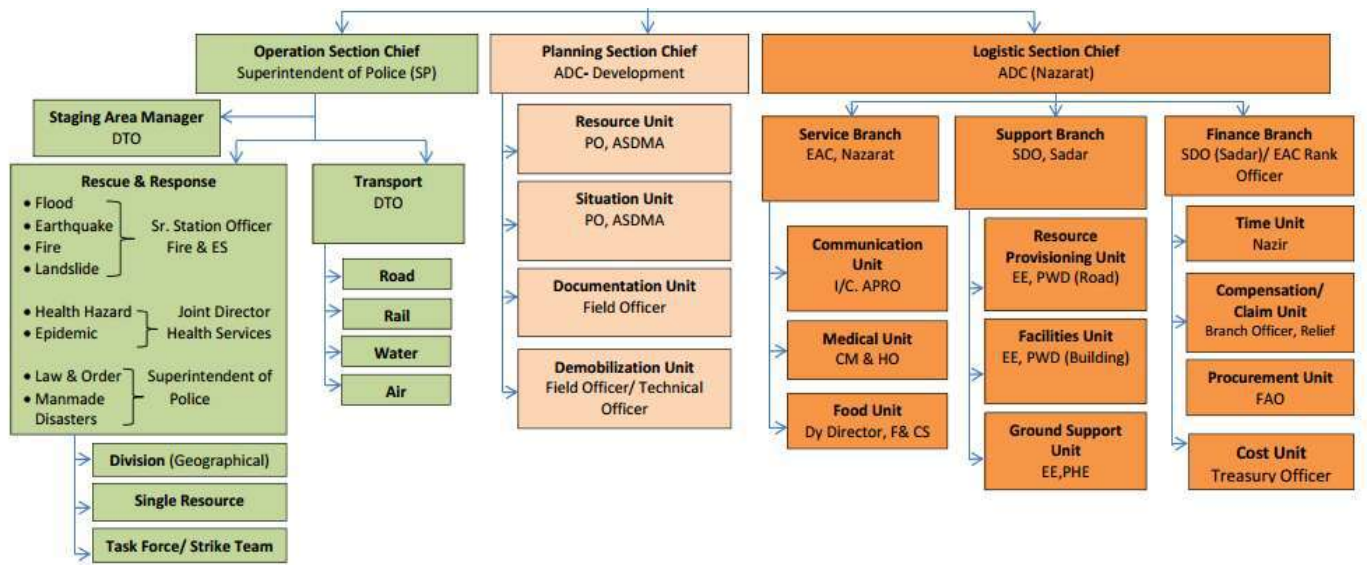

Guideline for Relief Camp Management:

Assam Disaster Management Manual-2015

On receipt of report from Revenue officials, the DC/SDO(C) will order to set up a relief camp at pre-decided location as per District/ Sub-divisional disaster management plan. As far as possible, relief camps should not be set up in educational institutions.

- In case new location is to be selected for the camp due to unavoidable circumstances, following points should be considered for arriving at a decision.
 - i. Camp should preferably be set up in an existing built up accommodation like a community hall.
 - ii. It should be located at a safe place which are not vulnerable to landslides, flood etc.
 - iii. It should be accessible by motor vehicles, if possible.
 - iv. Adequate space for roads, parking, drainage, should also be there.
 - v. The area should not be prone to endemic disease like malaria.
 - vi. Wide publicity should be given about the location of the camp and affected people should be evacuated and brought to the camp directly.
 - vii. Emergency relief materials which include drinking water, food, bedding (mattress, sheets & blankets), baby food, mosquito repellents etc. should be arranged as early as possible.
 - viii. Control room/ help desk should be setup in the relief camp immediately.
 - ix. Proper planning and preparedness to make the arrangement smoother.

Shelter:

- The shelter should be such that people have sufficient space for protection from adverse effects of the climate.

- Ensure sufficient warmth, fresh air, security and privacy for their health and well being.
- Each family should be provided separate tent, if possible.
- In warm & humid climates, proper ventilation & protection from direct sunlight must be ensured.
- If plastic tents or sheeting are available, provision of an insulating layer or a double skinned roof may be considered.
- Tents should not be constructed too closely together and reasonable distance should be kept between the camps to provide some form of privacy.
- Priority should be given to widows and women headed households, disabled and elderly people in tent/room distribution.
- Temporary shelter should neatly be planned and made.
- Tents with slanting sides should be avoided as they leave no space for mobility. Tents with ventilation facilities may be provided to the people.

General Administration of the Camp:

- One responsible officer preferably ADC/CO should be designated as Camp Officer by the DC who will ultimately be responsible for general management of the Relief Camp. He will co-ordinate & supervise the works of other officers in the camp.
- One Assistant Camp Officer should be designated to help the camp officer.

Guiding principles for Management of the Camp:

- Camp Officer should easily be accessible to the camp inhabitants.
- Treat every inhabitant of the camp with dignity and respect.
- Ideally camp management should strive to provide facilities so that inhabitants feel comfortable
- Make effective arrangement for distribution of food and aid to the people in the camp
- Special care should be taken to ensure that vulnerable people like disabled, elderly, pregnant women and children get adequate aid and supply of food and other facilities.
- Sufficient nos of women officers should be engaged in management of the camp and they should interact with women inhabitants to assess their special needs.
- Arrangement should be made to prevent abuse against women and children in the camp.
- Voluntary Organization & leading citizens may be encouraged and involve in management of relief camp.
- Psychological counselling must be arranged for the families who have lost their family members.
- Inhabitants should be involved in management of camp.
- Inhabitants should be kept engaged by arranging for TV, Books, News Papers, Carom Board and other means of entertainment.
- It should be ensured that no officer is required to work for unreasonably long hours.
- Officers responsible for management may be made aware that misappropriation of money or materials meant for the relief will invite prosecution and
- Special drive should be taken against illicit liquor sale in and around the camp.
- Press Release should be issued by giving contact nos of Nodal Officer who will accept and co-ordinate with NGOs & public regarding donation in cash & kind.
- People should be made aware about rehabilitation program, financial support and other compensation to be provided against the loss of house, crop, cattle etc.
- People should also be educated about NREGA & other employment generating schemes which are available in their locality as they need not migrate to cities for Job opportunities.

Basic Facilities:**Lighting Arrangement and Generator Set:**

- A technical person, preferably from electricity or PWD(E) department should be detailed to supervise the proper lighting arrangement in and around the camp and operation and maintenance of the generator set.
- One big candle and one match box should be provided in every room/tent.
- Petromax or emergency light should be arranged in sufficient numbers in the camp.
- Approach to toilet and water source should properly be illuminated.
- Generator set of required capacity should be installed in the Relief Camp and operator must be detailed for 24 hours.

Water Facilities:

- Total requirement of drinking water, water for toilets, bath & washing of clothes and Utensils should be assessed and proper arrangement should be made accordingly.
- Most of the diseases in the camps spread due to lack of purified and sufficient drinking water. Therefore serious effort should be made to ensure to supply adequate clean & purified water to the camp population. Permissible standard of TDP & other parameters for water must be maintained at any cost.
- 20 Ltrs of water should be provided to per person per day.
- One Sr. Officer of PHE Deptt. should be detailed for maintaining water supply in the camp.
- One bucket, one Jeri can or water container and one mug should be provided to every family to store the water for drinking, cooking etc.
- Ideally one hand pump should be installed for every 200 persons.
- Hand pumps or water tanks should be minimum 20 ft away from the toilets.
- Daily sample of water from tanks, taps & other sources should be collected and analysed in the district lab of PHE Deptt. Corrective measures should be taken as per result of water analyses.
- Commercially available water filter should preferably be installed. Makeshift arrangement for water purification may be avoided.
- Separate bathing units must be constructed for male & female.

Sanitation:

- Ideally there should be one toilet for 20 persons.
- Toilet should be minimum 10 mtrs and maximum 50 mtrs away from shelter/tent/room.
- For waste disposal, one communal pit of 2mX5mX2m of size should be dug for 500 persons.
- Each family should be provided one soap of 100 gram per week.
- Separate toilets should be constructed for men & women and these toilet blocks should be separately be located at reasonable distance.
- Sufficient light arrangement should be made in toilets.
- Approach from camp to toilets should be also properly illuminated.
- Sufficient stock of bleaching powder, harpic and others item should be maintained.
- One officer must separately be detailed to supervise regular cleaning and maintenance of the toilets.
- Requirement of disinfectants should be assessed regularly & sufficient stock of it week should be maintained in the camp.

- Food- Storage & Distribution and Cloths
- Initially for few days, cooked should be provided to the camp inhabitants. Utensils and cook may be hired from open market for cooking of the food.
- Preferably disposable plates and glasses may be used to serve the food and water for hygienic reasons. As far as practicable Food Inspector must be detailed to certify the food
- items before they are served. If cooked meal is not served, dry food like, rice, salt, pulse etc. may be distributed for one week at a time as per prescribed scale
- Even if cooked meal is provided to the inhabitants, above mentioned scale may be maintained.
- People in the camp should be provided sufficient clothing to protect themselves from the adverse effects of the climate. Women and girls should be provided necessary sanitary protection.
- Medical Facilities & Psycho-social Support
- Special Arrangement for women, Children, and Physically Challenged and Elderly persons
- Vermin control
- Security
- Media Management and Documentation
- Entertainment, Recreation & IEC Programme

Closure of the Camp:

- People in the camp should be encouraged to return to their homes, as the situation improves in the field. Transport facilities may be provided for the purpose.
- Family as a whole should leave the camp. No member of such family should be allowed to stay back in the camp.
- A final report may be prepared and sent to the govt with recommendation to amend the guidelines if required.

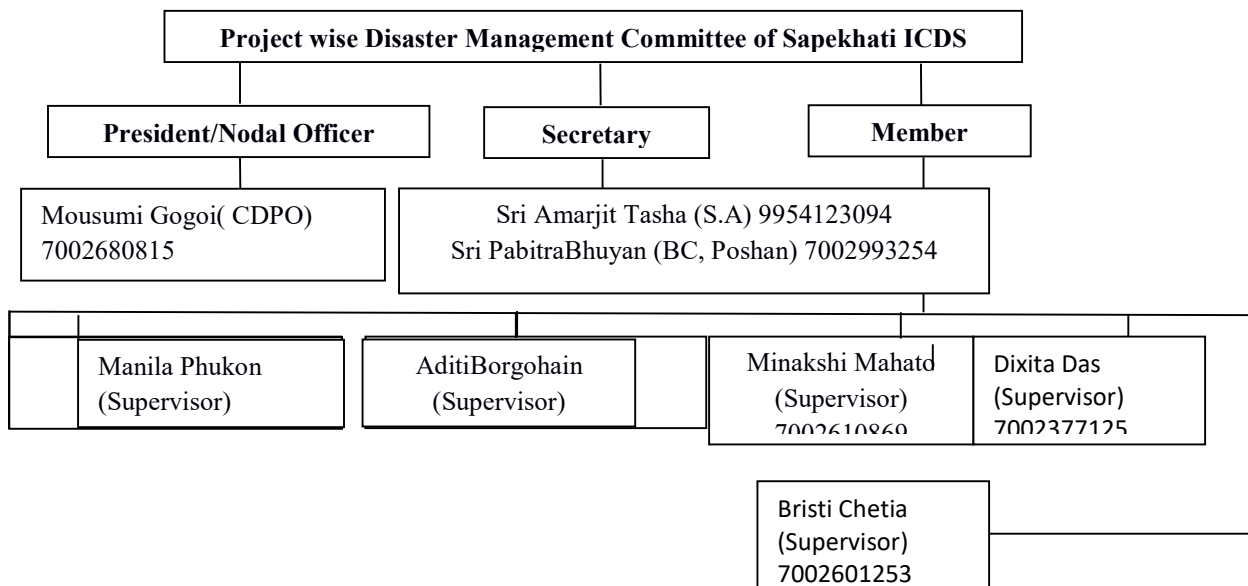

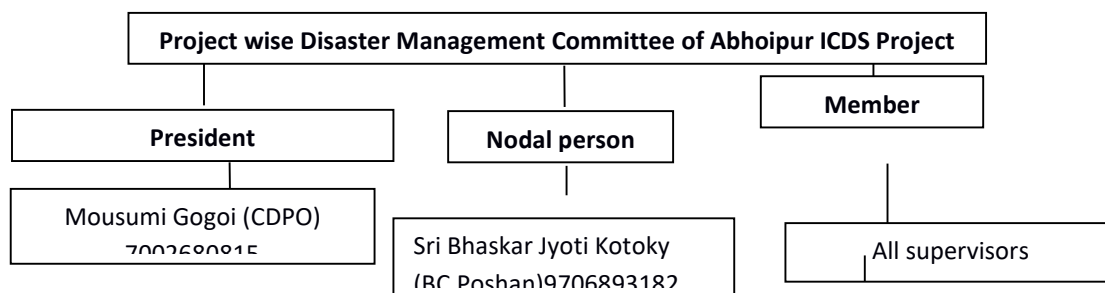

Regular activities of Emergency Operation Centre (EOC)

- **Operational period of DEOC** (The District Emergency Operation Centre (DEOC) is operational 24 x 7 x 365 basis)
- **Duty Hours** (The duty hours of the Information Assistant placed at DEOC is 8 hours a day in each shift.)
- **Transfer of Duty** (No on-duty Information Assistant will leave EOC after his/her duty hour is over without handing over duty to next incoming personnel)
- **Summary of the Shift** (Should brief/ summarise the activities of the past shift to incoming Information Assistant to before handing over his/her duty)
- **Daily Attendance** (Daily Attendance has to be signed without fail by persons deployed in each shift)
- **Duty Roster** (The duty roster of the EOC personnel should be prepared in such a way that at least 2 personnel are available in DEOC in each shift along with the APRO personnel / Satellite Phone operator.)
- **Communication Equipment** (Ensure that all equipment are functioning and if any repairing is required that has been brought to the notice of in-charge, SEOC immediately)
- **Receipt of Information** (Any information received form Administration/Police Control Room /News Channel or any other sources are to be noted down in Logbook/Register & inform in-charge of DEOC for further dissemination of the same. The DEOC should also keep soft copy & hard copy of the logbook/Register. Copies of any reports received or sent will be kept in different separate Index Files i.e. separate for Flood, Fire, and Strom etc.)
- **Information verification & dissemination** (The information will be verified or to be cross checked with ADC/CO/PO, ASDMA/Police Control Room/ Police Station/ Fire & Emergency Services of concerned area. After verification by the above mentioned authorities Information will be disseminated to the designated Contacts through SMS, if required.)
- **Maintenance & Updating contact details** [Contact details available in DEOCs will be updated periodically. EOC should maintain district wise contact details of officials of Revenue circle/subdivision/ district wise contact details of officials and responders (Police/ Fire & ES/SDRF etc.)]

Maintain Telephone Register & UPDATION of emergency numbers

- Every DEOC will maintain an updated Telephone register of all Emergency Support Functionaries (ESF)
- It must contain Tele-contact details of all district level ESF- Emergency Support Functionaries (DC, ADC, Circle Officers, SP, Police Stations, F& ES Stations & Officials, BDO, Hospitals/PHCs etc.)
- Each DEOC must send the updated list to the SEOC periodically (twice in a year- April & October)
- **During Flood Seasons (15th May To 30th October):**
- **Daily Flood Reporting** (DEOC should e-mail/ Fax the Daily Flood Report to SEOC latest by 12 Noon every day)
- **DEOC in-charge should ensure reporting of Daily flood report** (should be uploaded in online portal and e-mailed/ FAX the same to SEOC in time)
- **Reports on Rain fall data** (It should be communicated to the SEOC regularly)
- **FLEWS (Flood Early Warning System)**(FLEWS information should be disseminated to designate district & state level officials)
- A separate index file on **flood tracking will be maintained** by the DEOC personal after receiving the FLEWS alert)

1. INTRODUCTION

PHE department plays a key role in alleviation of problems related to drinking water and sanitation during various emergency situation. The steps generally taken up by the department during flood is relocation/rejuvenation of public source, installation of hand pumps in relief camps, disinfection of sources and distribution of chemical packets for preparation of potable water. During the post flood period besides disinfection of public sources. IEC activities are also taken up to educate the people regarding the steps to be adopted for disinfection of sources & the does and don'ts to rule out outbreak of diseases.

2. INFRASTRUCTURE

(a) Administrative

The Division has one Sub - Division which is manned by an Assistant Executive Engineer. For flood relief measure of Charaideo District, the 39nos. of GPs under PHE Division are headed by a Sectional Officer of the rank of Assistant Engineer / Junior Engineer/ Technical Officer. The Sectional Officers will be assisted by Sectional Assistant and Khalasi, who are actively engaged for flood relief measures at the field level (list of field level officer with telephone nos. enclosed). In case of flood, the sectional officers will co- ordinate with the respective Circle Officers and apprise the Executive Engineer and the AEE on a regular basis about the requirement of flood relief measures as per the ground conditions prevailing in his jurisdiction.

(b) Inventory of materials which can be used for flood relief measures

The Charaideo Public Health Engineering Division is at present in possession of the following materials which can be utilized for flood relief measures.

3. MODALITIES FOR FLOOD RELIEF MEASURES

(a) Temporary Water Supply Arrangements:

Normally Hand Tube Wells are installed to provide safe drinking water facilities for the population sheltered in the relief camp flood affected area. At present there is no stock of Hand Tube Wells which can be used for the same. If situation demands, installation of spot sources, the District Administration will have to arrange for hand tubewell

sets. The hand pumps will be installed as per pin point list provided by the District Administration. All technical support can be provided for installation of HTW in flood relief camp if pump sets are arranged from the District Administration Authority along with labour charge as per the requirement of the District Administration.

(b) Disinfection:

The materials required for disinfection of water sources are Bleaching Power, Lime, Alum and Halogen tablets. At the time of flood some packets are made by PHED with Bleaching Power, Lime and Alum to distribute to the affected house hold to disinfect the water sources. The public water sources are disinfected by our field staff. At present, this Division has a normal stock of the aforesaid materials. If additional amount required to tackle the situation, the undersigned will inform the District Administration in time besides taking up the matter with the higher authorities to arrange for the materials on an emergency basis. During the post flood period disinfection of public sources which were submerged will be required and disinfection of such sources will be undertaken as required. More over IEC activities will also be taken up on a limited scale to educate the public about the modalities for disinfection of their sources and the importance of doing so to avoid outbreak of diseases.

(c) Sanitation:

In some cases, if the situation arises, the department also takes up the task of construction of temporary pit latrines in relief camps. However, in such cases necessary funds will have to be arranged and the number and location of such temporary toilets will be provided as per list provided by the District Authorities.
