

**Minutes of the DDC meeting of Charaideo District held on 28-03-2022 at 11.00 AM in the Conference Hall of DC office, Charaideo**

Members present: As per ANNEXURE-I

The meeting was presided over by Sri Paul Barua, ACS, Deputy Commissioner, Charaideo. The Chairman welcomed all the members present in the meeting. The meeting was initiated with the discussion on the action points of the following development departments.

**1. PWD (Bldg.):** The Ex. Eng. PWD (bldg.) informed that the construction works of the schemes are going on smoothly. The DC opined that those schemes which have completed 85% and above should be completed immediately and handed over to the user groups. The Ex. Eng. PWD(B) informed that four model schools in tea garden area have been completed. He was directed to hand over the schools to the IS Charaideo urgently. The IS, Charaideo informed that inauguration of the schools would be done centrally by the Govt. The Ex. Eng. PWD(B) also informed that the physical & financial progress of Medical College, Charaideo is almost 25%.

With regards to painting of the DC office, the DC asked the Ex. Engineer to submit plan & Estimate for onward submission to GAD for approval so that work may started soon after getting necessary approval from GAD, Assam. Regarding construction of amalgamated DC office, DC asked the Ex. Eng. PWD(B) to visit the proposed site along with the ADC (Dev) and if necessary one Architecture may also be requested for site plan. Regarding DC's residential Building & Officers' quarter, the Ex. Eng. PWD(B) would take immediate steps for sending proposal to GAD for approval through district administration.

**2. PHE:** While discussing on Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM), the DC asked the Engineer to complete 1000 more FHTC by the end of the month. He was also directed to expedite the FHTC to achieve the target. With regards the detailed report on sanitation, the Ex. Eng. PHE was asked to submit the report only after completion of physical inspection conducted by CO's.

**3. Education:** The IS & DEEO informed that 3 (three) HE schools have been upgraded to Higher Secondary school, viz. Bishrampur HSS, Safrai HSS & Raidongia HSS. He also informed that the list of teachers for Tea Garden Model schools have been prepared and sent to the DSE for approval. He further informed that the proposal of 8 (Eight) schools have submitted for Heritage school but sanction is yet to be received for construction. The DC directed the IS to take necessary action for arrangement of benches & desks for Tea Garden Model Schools which would be started from 1<sup>st</sup> April/2022.

**4. Water Resource:** The Ex. Eng. stated that out of eleven sanctioned schemes under SDRF, three schemes have been completed and the works of remaining eight schemes are going on. The DC directed the EE Water Resource to complete all the scheme, before the onset of monsoon.

**5. Forest:** The DFO (T) informed that all proposals regarding forest clearance have to be submitted to Govt. with a copy to PCCF. He also stated that due to shortage of manpower, the department has been facing difficulties to perform their activities effectively. The DFO (S/F) informed that the proposal regarding plantation of 75 sapling in every school has been submitted to the Govt. but no fund has been sanctioned so far. The DC stated that since the season for plantation of trees has been started, the DFO(S/F) should take individual step for successful implementation of the scheme and supply the saplings from existing nurseries to the schools immediately.

**6. Irrigation:** The Ex. Eng. Irrigation informed that all schemes under PMKSY-IKKP (Ph-I) tube well have been completed. Regarding MDTWS at Mahmora LAC (3pts) under RIDF-XXVI programme, it is in tendering progress. The Chairman directed to submit the photographs of all completed schemes and to take necessary action to expedite the RIDF-XXVI programme.

**7. Industry & Commerce:** The Asstt. Director, DICCC stated that under PMEGP, 66 applications were received against the target of 67 beneficiaries and all applications were sponsored to different bank branches. Out of the sponsored applications, 12 applications have been sanctioned by bank so far. He stated that online submission of application is going on. Under



PMFME, 50 applications were received against the target of 35 beneficiaries. Out of fifty applications, four applications have been sponsored to banks and the remaining forty-six applications are in draft stage. He informed the meeting that online application has been uploaded regarding One District One Product (Charaideo rice).

**8. P & RD:** The CEO, Zila Parishad informed that under MGNREGA, 85% schemes have been completed and the remaining 15% (1060 schemes) are in progress. The schemes taken up under MGNREGA are generally for Fishery development, Land development, Minor irrigation, renovation of traditional Water Bodies, Rural Connectivity etc. The Chairman directed to all BDOs to inspect the schemes properly and check the quality of the work. He also directed to expedite the AADHAR seeding with Job card process and advise to hold meeting with G.P. Secy. in this regard.

**9. PWD (R):** The Ex. Eng. informed that the alignment problem under Assam Mala Project in Sapekhati area has yet to be solved. The DC asked the Ex. Eng. to submit the location points of the road chainage where the obstacles are faced and the name of persons who involved in this matter urgently for taking necessary action from district administration. The DC stated that before taking initiative from district authority, the PWD(R) & CO, Sapekhati would try to settle the issue amicably. Unless the problem is settled, the District Administration in liaison with Police would take appropriate action on the matter. The Ex. Eng. PWD(R) was asked to repair the potholes near Suffry and Tengapukhuri area immediately.

**10. Social Welfare:** The DC asked the DSWO to settle the pending electricity bill of CDPO office at Sapekhati in consultation with the BDO Sapekhati. The DSWO informed that out of 22 sanctioned model Anganwadi centres, 2<sup>nd</sup> instalment for four Anganwadi centre has been released. The Chairman directed to gear up the pace of progress of construction work and complete all model Anganwadi centres by May/2022. The DSWO informed that the Anemia camp would be organised in liaison with Health Department soon.

**11. Health:** The Jt. DHS, Charaideo stated that the 2<sup>nd</sup> dose of vaccination of COVID-19 above 18-year is 83.2%. Under National Tuberculosis Elimination Programme (NTEP), 229 patients are under treatment. He informed that 14 patients have been cured and released during the month of February/2022. The Chairman directed the Jt. DHS to identify the area for post mortem room and take necessary action for construction immediately and he was also advised to install the required equipment in ICU immediately.

**12. Agriculture:** The DAO, Charaideo informed that 52000 Qntl. paddy has been collected out of targeted 55500 Qntl. under Paddy Procurement programme. AADHAR updation for PMKISHAN is going on. He stated that plantation of traditional fruit bearing trees have been completed in the agricultural land at Longpotia.

**13. Veterinary:** The DVO stated that National Animal Disease Control Programme (NADCP) has yet to be started due to non-receive of Vaccine from Govt.

**14. Sericulture:** The meeting discussed the sericulture schemes taken up under world bank finance APART programme 2019-2020, 2020-21 & RKVY 2018-19. This relates to Eri house, Plantation of Som/Kesseru. The DC directed to expedite the scheme to meet the target on stipulated time.

**15. Handlooms & Textile:** The Supdt. of handloom & Textile stated that under APART programme for the year 2021-22, 100% Physical achievement has been completed. Training of Twenty weavers at Charaideo CFC, Lakwa, for a duration of ten days has been going on in the categories of Skill development, Designing, etc. under this programme. He apprised the meeting that SAMARTH scheme is under process. He informed that under Weavers' MUDRA Loan, sanctioned accorded by banks against eight weavers during the financial year 2021-22.


**16. Fishery:** The meeting discussed on the Progress of the scheme RIDF-XXIII - "Ghare Ghare khuri Ghare Ghare Maach" (2018-19), RKVY-RAFTAAR (2019-20), PMMSY (2020-21). The Chairman directed to speed up the implementation process of the schemes to fulfil the objectives Govt.

17. **Transport:** The DTO stated that the target for collection of revenue for the district during this year was Rs. 5.00 Crore and out of which an amount of Rs 5.7516472 crore has been collected with an achievement of 115.03%. The chairman directed to organise awareness programme on Road Safety among the Public.

18. **Food & Civil Supply:** The Asstt. Director, F&CS informed that the approval of AADHAR seeding has been going on and the achievement till date is 61%. The DC directed to complete 100% seeding process by April/2022. He stated that a review meeting on the matter has been fixed by the Hon'ble Chief Minister in the month of April/2022.

In conclusion , the Deputy Commissioner requested all implementing departments to complete all ongoing schemes by May/2022 and submit UC to Govt. He stated that while implementing the schemes , the departments should take special care to maintain quality of works so that the fund sanctioned by govt. may create durable assets and the beneficiaries may be benefitted from such quality product.


