

**Minutes of the DDC meeting for the month of May/2022 in respect of Charaideo
District held on 30-05-2022 at 11.00 AM in the Conference Hall of DC office,
Charaideo**

Members present: As per ANNEXURE-I

The meeting was presided over by Sri Paul Barua, ACS, Deputy Commissioner, Charaideo. The Chairman welcomed all the members present in the meeting. The meeting was initiated with the discussion on the action points of the following development departments.

1. Food & Civil Supply: The Asstt. Director, F&CS informed that the ADHAR seeding of beneficiaries has been going on and the achievement till date is 58%. The DC directed to expedite the process and improve 10% more by the 1st week of July/2022. The Asstt. Director informed that Paddy procurement has been achieved 1571 MT (28%) out of targeted 5550 MT in the district.

2. PHE: While discussing on Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM), the Ex. Engineer informed that 26528 FHTC has been installed against the targeted 36125 FHTC so far. Out of 775 schools, 592 schools have been provided tape connection. Moreover 157 AWC have been provided tape connection under JJM in the district. He was directed to expedite the FHTC to achieve the target. He appraised that 30 (thirty) water user committees have been formed and 17 schemes handed over to the user committees. The DC directed to expedite the works to complete all the schemes.

3. Water Resource: The Ex. Eng. stated that out of eleven sanctioned schemes under SDRF, three schemes have been completed and the works of remaining eight schemes are going on. The DC directed the EE Water Resource to complete all the schemes in stipulated time fixed by Govt.

5. Forest: The DFO (T) informed that Rs. 6.67725 lakh revenue has been collected during the year 2022-23. He appraised that 450 tree species, 40 Orchid species & 23 bamboo species were planted in the Bio diversity Park- "Sahitya Manishi Upabon" at Sola Reserved Forest under state CAMPA scheme which was inaugurated by Sri Sarbananda Sonowal Hon'ble Central Minister on 2nd February, 2021. The DC directed to complete the plantation of 75 sapling in every school. The DC stated that since the season for plantation of trees has been started, the DFO(S/F) should take individual step for successful implementation of the scheme and supply the saplings from existing nurseries to the schools immediately.

6. Irrigation: The Ex. Eng. Irrigation informed that all schemes under PMKSY-IKKP (Ph-I) tube well have been completed. Regarding MDTWS at Mahmora LAC (3pts) under RIDF-XXVI programme, it is in tendering progress. The Chairman directed to submit the photographs of all completed schemes and to take necessary action to expedite the RIDF-XXVI programme.

7. Industry & Commerce: The Asstt. Director, DICC stated that under PMEGP, 6 applications were received against the target of 84 beneficiaries and applications were sponsored to different bank branches. Under PMFME scheme, 129 applications were received against the target of 52 beneficiaries. He stated that ten applications have been submitted to banks and the remaining applications are in draft stage.

9. PWD (R): The Asstt. Eng. informed that the survey of Nahar Ali Road in length of 42 KM under Assam Mala Project has been completed. 33% of the road work has been completed so far and the disbursement of compensation may be started from November/2022. The DC directed to submit a detailed report of the road chainage for which compensation to be given.

10. Social Welfare: The DSWO informed that out of 22 sanctioned model Anganwadi centres, four Anganwadi centre has been inaugurated and five Anganwadi centres would be completed within fifteen days. Progress of remaining Anganwadi centres is about 60%. Geo Tagging of A.W. Centres is completed. With regards to PMMVY, the DSWO informed that 1978 has been achieved against the target of 2335. The Deputy Commissioner directed to gear up the pace of progress of all construction works and complete all model Anganwadi centres.

11. Health: The Jt. DHS, Charaideo stated that the 2nd dose of vaccination of COVID-19 above 18-year is 90.46%. Under Atal Amrit Abhiyan, 31 patients got benefitted at Sonari Civil Hospital. Under AYUSHMAN BHARAT DIGITAL MISSION, 23 Health facility registered so far. Under National Tuberculosis Elimination Programme (NTEP), 239 patients are under treatment. The Jt. Director Health Services informed that Health Melas in convergence with the Social Welfare deptt. have been organised twice during 2021-22.

12. Agriculture: The DAO, Charaideo informed that 52000 Qntl. paddy has been collected out of targeted 55500 Qntl. under Paddy Procurement programme. Sanction of PM Kishan and KCC is going on and 4720 have been sanctioned out of targeted 11396 so far. PM kishan re-

verification have been completed and ADHAAR seeding of 7354 beneficiaries also completed. He stated that buyers & Sellers Mela in the district has been done.

13. **Veterinary:** The DVO stated that National Animal Disease Control Programme (NADCP) has yet to be started due to non-receive of Vaccine from Govt.

14. **Sericulture:** The meeting discussed the sericulture schemes taken up under world bank finance APART programme 2019-2020, 2020-21 & RKVY 2018-19. This relates to Eri house, Plantation of Som/Kesseru. The DC directed to expedite the schemes to achieve the target within the stipulated time.

15. **Handlooms & Textile:** The Supdt. of Handloom & Textile stated that under APART programme for the year 2021-22, 100% Physical achievement has been completed. He apprised the meeting that SAMARTH scheme is under process. He informed that under Weavers' MUDRA Loan, sanctioned accorded by banks against eight weavers out of physical target 50 nos. of beneficiaries during the financial year 2021-22.

16. **Fishery:** The meeting discussed on the Progress of the scheme RIDF-XXIII - "Ghare Ghare Pukhuri Ghare Ghare Maach" (2018-19), RKVY-RAFTAAR (2019-20), PMMSY (2020-21). The chairman directed to speed up the implementation of the schemes to fulfil the objectives of Govt. Further, he was directed to submit a detailed report regarding availability and implementation of community ponds in the district.

17. **Transport:** The DTO stated that Rs. 1.0281911 Crore revenue collection have been done in the district during the year 2022-23. As per direction of DC to organise awareness programme on Road Safety among the Public, the deptt. organised two awareness programmes in the month of April/2022. The DTO informed that the deptt. has taking initiative for registering the E-Rickshaws plying in Sonari Town. He informed that penalty has been imposed against twenty defaulting E-Rickshaws and an amount of Rs. 96,500 imposed as fine and seized the vehicles.

18. **PWD (Bldg.):** The Ex. Eng. PWD (bldg.) informed that the construction works of the scheme are going on smoothly. The DC advised that those schemes which have completed 85% and above should be completed immediately and handed over to the user groups.

In conclusion, the Deputy Commissioner stated that GUNOTSAV Programme in the district is completed successfully w.e.f. 12th May to 14th May/2022. He stated that during this rainy season, the deptts. should take special care for implementation of schemes in time bound manner so that the target fixed by govt. may be achieved well in advanced.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks from the Chair.
