The meeting was chaired by Smti Dinchengfa Boruah, ACS, Co-District Commissioner, Mahmora Co-District. The meeting was graced by the esteemed presence of: **Shri Pabitra Margherita , Hon'ble Minister of State for External Affairs of India; Shri Suruj Dehingia, Hon'ble MLA, Mahmora Legislative Assembly Constituency;** Smti Neha Yadav, IAS, District Commissioner, Charaideo district; Shri Surjit Singh Panesar, APS, Superintendent of Police, Charaideo . The meeting was also attended by Shri Gajanand Sharma, APS, CDSP, Mahmora Co-District; Assistant Commissioners, Circle Officer, Block Development Officers and all Heads of Departments/ Representatives of Mahmora LAC.

The Chairperson warmly welcomed all the dignitaries, officials, and departmental heads, outlined the agenda of the meeting, and initiated a departmental review covering ongoing projects and development initiatives.

Shri Pabitra Margherita, Hon'ble Minister of State for External Affairs of India, delivered a brief speech highlighting the core significance of the Co-DDC framework. In his address to the departmental officers present, the Hon'ble Minister emphasized how the efficient and coordinated functioning of individual government departments plays a vital role in the overall smooth governance and delivery of public services.
