

**Minutes of the DDC meeting for the month of August/2022 in respect of Charaideo District held on 31-08-2022 at 11.00 AM in the Conference Hall of DC office, Charaideo**

Members present: As per ANNEXURE-I

The meeting was presided over by Sri Paul Barua, ACS, Deputy Commissioner, Charaideo. The Chairman welcomed all the members present in the meeting. The meeting was initiated with the discussion on the action points of the following development departments.

- 1. District Skill Dev:** The DPM, ASDM, informed that for preparation of Action Plan of the department, feedback & suggestion from line departments are required. The Deputy Commissioner suggested that the DPM/MGNF of the department should personally meet the departments concerned and obtain feedback and suggestion from them and prepare a Master Plan on the basis of discussion and feedback of the departments. The DC suggested that milestone of the proposed training programme on different categories to clearly be mentioned in the Master Plan. The Officer of Skill Dev. Department was asked to convene meeting of the district only after preparation of the Master Plan.
- 2. Social Welfare:** The DSWO informed that construction of Model Anganwadi centres have been completed. She stated that AADHAAR seeding with Anganwadi beneficiaries is 89.95%. The DSWO informed that construction of "SAKHI" One Stop Center in Dakhin Sonari has been completed and the bldg. Was inaugurated by the Hon'ble MP(LS) 12 HPC Jorhat on 16-08-2022. The meeting also discussed on PMMVY, UDID card, POSHAN etc.
- 3. PHE:** The Ex. Engineer informed that the target of FHTC under JJM was 53899. Out of the target, achievement up to the end of August/22 was 997. The target of Tap connection in school was 775 and out of which achievement was 655. Similarly, the target of Tap connection in AWC's was 215 and out of which achievement was 172. The Deputy Commissioner urged upon the Ex. Engineer to work hard for timely achieving the target set by the Govt.
- 4. PWD (R):** The Ex. Eng. PWD(R) informed that a few process of land acquisition of Nahar Ali Road under Assam Mala Project is yet to be completed. The DC directed the Ex. Eng. PWD(R) to lead the work and complete the process of clearance from all the deptt within a week. During discussion the progress of the departmental activities, the Ex. Eng. stated that overall 20% physical work has been made during this month and all carpeting works would be completed within October/2022. He informed that out of 112 KM, 98 KM road construction has been completed and the remaining portion of roads would be completed in the winter season.
- 5. PWD (Bldg.):** The Ex. Eng. PWD (bldg.) informed that cumulative physical progress of Medical college is 29%. He appraised that formal notice has been issued to the contractor for slow progress of Zilla Parishad building. For renovation works of DC office building, works would be allotted within 10 days. The DC viewed serious concern upon the slow progress of DTO office building and directed the Ex. Eng. to take necessary action for speedy implementation of the project. The DC asked the Ex. Eng. to submit list of low laying areas where proposed Govt. construction works to be started, so that the sites could be developed by the soil coming out from the excavation in Amrit Sarovar scheme. He also directed to complete the process of disposal of pending running bill if any immediately so that contractors could complete all Govt. constructions without waiting for fund.
- 6. Education:** The Inspector of Schools, Charaideo, informed that data entry process for verification of DISE code has been going on. He further informed that 55 schools have been amalgamated with 39 schools. The DC directed the IS to take necessary step for implementation of New Education Policy (NEP) after completion the process of amalgamation and rationalisation of teachers. He also directed to verify the schools which do not have fans, electricity facilities.
- 7. PWD (NH):** While discussing the progress of NH Division, the DC directed the Asstt. Ex. Eng. (PWD, NH Div) to submit a report on land records/documents of land acquisition in Sapekhati area.
- 8. Water Resources:** The Ex. Eng. Water Resource deptt. stated that out of nine sanctioned schemes under SDRF, two schemes have been completed and the remaining works could be started from October/2022. The DC directed the E.E. Water Resource to complete all the schemes within the stipulated time fixed in the tender document.



9. **Irrigation:** The Ex. Eng. Irrigation stated that under PMKSY, boring of 200 tube wells (Solar & Electric) have been completed and all are in operation. He stated that two schemes were sanctioned under RIDF-XXVI (NABARD) and the boring of both the schemes has been done.
10. **Forest:** The DFO informed that plantation of sapling could be covered 50 hect. area under CAMPA, 1.30 lakh. The DC suggested to take steps for afforestation and motivate the local people. Much awareness among the villagers to save trees and wild animal is indispensable. He also asked to manage the vacant posts with contractual engagement until the vacancy posts are filled up by the Govt.
11. **P & R D:** The DC directed the BDOs to expedite the AADHAAR seeding with job card holders under MGNREGA and complete the process immediately. He also directed the BDO's to expedite the PMAY-G schemes.
12. **Health:** The meeting was discussed on the COVID-19 vaccination, Mother & Child Health, Institutional Delivery, MMR & IMR, CM free diagnostic service, PM free dialysis programme, Atal Amrit Abhiyan, Ayushman Bharat, NELP, NVBDCP, NTEP etc. The Jt. Director, Health Services informed that the 2<sup>nd</sup> dose of vaccination of COVID-19 above 18-year is 81.02%. The DC requested the Jt. Director, Health to get ready for 4<sup>th</sup> wave of COVID-19.
13. **Agriculture:** The DAO informed that 96% of Aadhar Seeding under PM-Kishan has been achieved. He stated that out of 20697, uploading of 4963 land record data in the PM-Krishan portal has been completed. With regards the eKYC under PM-Krishan, 82% has been achieved so far. He also informed that under PMFBY, uploading of data in portal is in progress and 2825 beneficiaries have been uploaded in portal till date. The DAO mentioned that paddy procurement in the district is 472.00 qtls.
14. **Veterinary:** The DVO stated that under National Animal Disease Control Programme (NADCP), 30,000 doses of vaccine have been received. Out of which, 29,892 vaccinations and 733 Brucellosis vaccination have been done.
15. **Fishery:** The meeting discussed on the Progress of the scheme RIDF-XXIII - "Ghare Ghare Pukhuri Ghare Ghare Maach" (2018-19), RKVY-RAFTAAR (2019-20), PMMSY (2020-21). The Chairman directed to expedite all schemes under fishery deptt.
16. **Industry & Commerce:** The Asstt. Director, DICC stated that under PMEGP, 30 applications were received against the target of 84 beneficiaries and 27 applications were sponsored to different bank branches. Out of the sponsored applications, 2 applications have been sanctioned by bank so far. Under PMFME, 131 applications were received against the target of 52 beneficiaries. Out of received applications, 10 applications have been sponsored to banks but no sanction have been made by banks so far.
17. **Transport:** The DTO stated that out of the target of ₹ 8.00 crore, Rs. 2.964687 crore revenue has been collected in the district during the year 2022-23.
18. **Soil Conservation:** The DO Soil conservation, Jorhat stated that out of three projects taken up under RIDF-XXV during the year 2020-21, work of one project has been completed. The DO Soil informed that under RIDF-XXVII, 2021-22, two project proposals with an estimated cost of ₹ 108.60 lakh have been taken up.
19. **Sericulture:** The meeting discussed the sericulture schemes taken up under world bank finance, APART programme 2019-2020, 2020-21 & RKVY 2018-19. This relates to Eri house, Plantation of Som/Kesseru. The DC directed to expedite the schemes to meet the target on stipulated time.
20. **Handlooms & Textile:** The Supdt. of Handloom & Textile stated that under APART programme for the year 2021-22, 100% Physical achievement has been completed. He apprised the meeting that SAMARTH scheme is under process. He informed that under Weavers' MUDRA Loan, target for 50 weavers has been received during the financial year 2022-23.

In conclusion, the Deputy Commissioner requested all implementing departments to complete the ongoing schemes as early as possible. The meeting ended with a vote of thanks from the Chair.
